

Walsworth Takes Pac-10 Tournament

The Stanford men's golfers completed an inconsistent season which was highlighted by senior Don Walsworth's individual win at the Pac-10 tournament. "This was easily Don's finest performance in college," said Stanford coach Tim Schaaf. Walsworth shot a one-under-par 71 in the final round to beat defending NCAA champion Sam Randolph from USC on his home course. Walsworth's come-frombehind victory earned the Cardinal a fourth-place tie with UCLA behind West Coast powers USC, Oregon, and Arizona State.

Stanford's Pac-10 finish earned the Cardinal a berth in the NCAA tournament held in North Carolina. Seniors Don Walsworth, Carl Wagner, and Phil Rowley joined with freshmen Brad Greer and Roger Minaglia in the national meet. Throughout the season the Cardinal's play was inconsistent, highlighted by a strong finish at the BYU invitational and a victory at the Stanford Invitational, but the Stanford men failed to make the cut for the final round of 20 teams at the NCAA tournament. Pac-10 champion Don Walsworth was the only Cardinal linkster to qualify for the final round.

The Stanford women followed an outstanding fall season that left them ranked third nationally with a mediocre spring season. Stanford never finished higher than fourth in any tournament and ended the Pacific West Conference Championships in fifth, placing them last in the field. Despite their disappointing spring performance, the Cardinal women entered the NCAA tournament seeded fourth. Coached by Tim Baldwin, the Cardinal contingent of Julie Carmichael, Kathleen McCarthy, Kay Cornelius, Kathy Kostas, and Adrienne Gilmartin couldn't



end their late season slump. The Cardinal women fell to fifteenth place after a poor final round at the NCAA's in Ohio. McCarthy led Stanford with a final score of 309 followed by Carmichael at 310.
